Role-Based Licensing

Customers have the choice of two concurrent user types, **Team Member** and **Full User**. Both licensing models are designed to simplify the purchasing process by providing the right level of access by role.

Team Members predominately consume data and reports and complete light tasks like time entry.

Full Users leverage the majority of business apps' functionality. They have also been referred to as "power users." All licenses include automatic product updates. The **Full User** license includes the rights for one external accountant user to access the service at no additional cost. The license for this user has to be requested separately.
